

**WEB UPDATE – CONFIRMATION OF RESULTS OF E-GBM OF  
RAMAN VIHAR, COIMBATORE PROJECT**

1. AWHO, in accordance with Para 76 of Master Brochure, elects an Adhoc User Committee (AUC) and thereafter election for Residents Welfare Association (RWA) are conducted. This has been implemented in all projects of AWHO in past 40 years.
2. However, Raman Vihar Apartment Owners Association (RVAOA) was registered by few allottees under Tamil Nadu Societies Act, bypassing the provisions and procedures as prescribed in AWHO's Master Brochure. This was objected to by AWHO.
3. RVAOA filed a Writ Petition (WP) in Madras High Court and obtained a 'Stay' for formation of AUC. The case was subjudice for a long time. On 18 February 2021, verbal orders of the Hon'ble High Court directed RVAOA to conduct an e-GBM to break the stalemate. RVAOA has filed the confirmation of conduct of e-GBM to Hon'ble High Court on 27 February 2021.
4. Madras High Court has now verbally directed AWHO to confirm the claims of RVAOA, to resolve the issue. A link for e-voting has been sent all the allottees on their registered e-mail ID with AWHO. All allottees are requested to cast their e-vote latest by **0900 hrs on 16 March 2021.**
6. The collated results will be produced before the Madras High Court on **18 March 2021.**
7. In case of change of Mobile Number / e-mail ID registered with HQ AWHO, allottees are requested to forward application for updating the same **latest by 0900hrs on 15 March 2021 positively** through email.
8. Instructions for e-voting are as under:-
  - (a) One allottee can cast only one vote.
  - (b) AWHO will accept the vote received from registered Mobile Number / e-mail ID.
