## <u>DETAILS FOR CONVERSION OF MYSORE DEMAND SURVEY (DS) REGISTRATION</u> TO ANNUAL REGISTRATION (AR)

- 1. Existing demand survey registrants (Except Priority II registrant) who fulfill the eligibility criteria as given in the AWHO Master Brochure Jul 1987 (as amended) of Mysore, Kesare may convert their registration into Annual Registration prior to issue of booking letter.
